**Regarding: REACH Compliance**

FMC Corporation (FMC) and its subsidiaries including Cheminova A/S are fully aware of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH Regulation) as amended, which outlines the framework for chemicals management in the European Union.

It is hereby confirmed that all FMC products are in full compliance with the REACH Regulation, meaning that the chemical substances contained in these products:

- have been registered by FMC and/or our subsidiaries and/or our suppliers or
- are excluded from the REACH Regulation and/or
- are exempted from registration

The active ingredients in FMC Plant Protection Products (PPPs) are covered by the plant protection Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009 (repealing directive 91/414/EEC) and they are extensively evaluated in that context. Therefore, they are considered as already registered according to the REACH-Regulation Article 15.

FMC is in continual communication with our suppliers about REACH compliance of supplied chemicals and the procedures around production and distribution of these. Should anything related to this REACH compliance of supplied chemicals change or should new relevant information become available, we will take steps to inform customers and any other relevant stakeholders immediately.
